## Workshops

Workshops will be about 60 minutes in length and will be presented by EurECA conference delegates on a variety of topics related to teachers' well-being.

## Conference Costs

The total cost for the Conference per person (including accommodation, meals, and conference fees) is **100 €** for the "Students' dorm accommodation" option at Bucha, or **210 €** (in double room) and **250 €** (in single room) in hotel accommodation nearby (with transport between the hotel and the Institute), for early registrations made until April 1. For registrations after April 1, the cost will be **20 €** more. For international daily participants, the conference fee is **30 €** per day, which includes lunch and dinner. There will be also an additional charge for the optional excursion to the beautiful city of Kyiv.

## Travel

The Ukrainian Institute of Arts and Sciences is located in Bucha, (North-West of the city of Kyiv), at about 33 km from Kyiv International Airport (Zhuliany) and at about 65 km from Boryspil Kyiv Airport. We will organise one shuttle bus from each airport to the conference centre.
