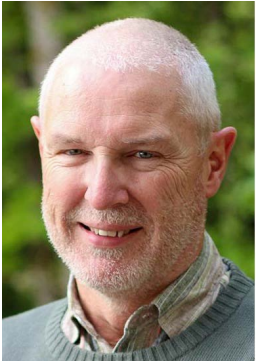

Plenary sessions

Dr. Ken Badley currently teaches foundations of education at Mount Royal University in Calgary, Alberta. As well as teaching in secondary, under-graduate, and graduate settings in Canada and the United States, he has also worked with teachers in Kenya on seven occasions. He serves on the editorial board of the "New Educational Review" and as book review editor for the "International Journal of Christianity and Education". Recent publications include 'Echoes of



Insight: Past Perspectives and the Future of Christian Higher Education' (2016, with Patrick Allen), "Faith and Learning: A Guide for Faculty" (2014, with Patrick Allen), and "Educational Foundations in Canada" (2014, with Jodi Nickel and Allen Edmonds). Ken lives in Calgary, Alberta with his wife, K. Jo-Ann Badley.

Professor Dr. Detchko Svilenov studied Orthodox theology and medicine. For 36 years he has been working in the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences in the field of medical research and also at the Medical University of Ulm in Germany. He has written many medical and Christian books: "Evolution and Creation in the Light of Science", "Sexuality and Sex - What Does the Bible Say?", "The Question of God's Existence", "Life After Death", "Health Disease Suffering - Medical and Biblical Aspects", "Christianity and Islam - Two Completely Different Religions. Where is the Truth?", "The True God" as well as others. His wife and the eldest son are medical doctors, his youngest son is a dentist who lives in the US. In 1994 he founded the Friends of Bulgaria Foundation. After the political changes in 1989, he started printing and distributing children's bibles and books on Christian ethics in the government schools across Bulgaria, to date the total has reached 4 million.



Workshops

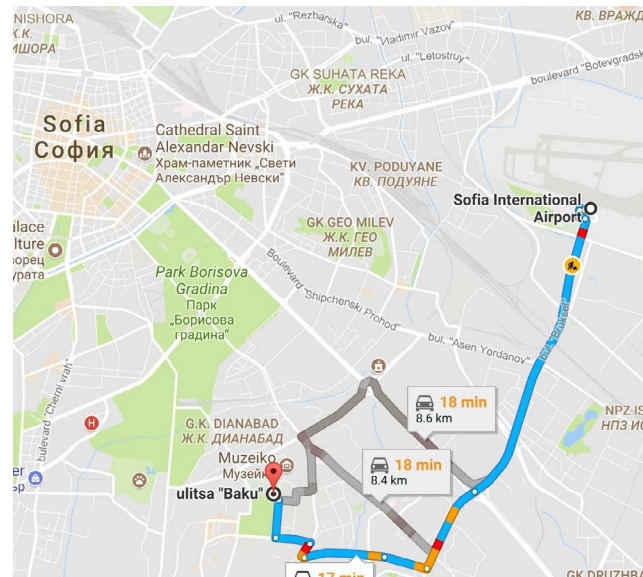
Workshops will be 60 minutes in length and will be presented by EurECA conference delegates on a variety of topics relevant to Christian educators from all nations.

Conference Costs

The total cost for the Conference time per person (including accommodation, meals, and conference fees) is € 210 (double room) / € 255 (single room) for early registrations made until March 31. For registrations after April 1, the cost will be € 20 more. For **Bulgarian daily participants**, the conference fee is **35 leva per day**, which includes lunch and dinner. There is the possibility to come earlier and/or to leave later, paying an extra cost. There will be also an additional charge for some of the optional excursions
